Guests and members can then, with just a couple of taps on the screen, get their player handicap for the course and available tee boxes. No more paper or framed conversion tables mounted on the wall or laying around the reception area.

When the slope, course rating and course length are changed, the club can simply update this in the system and the conversion tables are automatically adjusted.
